Lūšis

Lynx

Live in larger forests. Feed on mice, voles, roe deer, but usually attacks weaker, the sick animal. Man avoids.



Stumbras Bison

Bison - currently the largest wild beasts. Bison short trunk, the front part of a high ridge. Large, heavy, head. Eyes small.



Perkūno oželis Common snipe



Loins side printed in black, brown and bright brown spots. Beak straight, much longer than the head, dark brown.

Taurusis elnias

Red deer

A deer's body is lean and strong. The legs are relatively thin. On the head it has large horns.



Baltasis kiškis

White rabbit

White rabbit -lagomorph mammal, which is slightly smaller than the gray hare. Weighing about 3.5 kg. In the summer coat is gray. In summer, white rabbits feed on herbaceous vegetation, in the winter eating bark



Juodasis gandrās


Black stork

The head, neck, dewlap, the upper half of the body black. Breast and wing underside are white. Beak, legs, and ring around the eyes are red. This is a very cautious and evasive human bird.



Ereelis žuvininkas

Osprey



The lower part of the body white and slightly mottled. Beak black, nails look powerful, big, black. Legs relatively long.

Jūrinis erelis

Wite-tailed eagle



This is a very large and one representative of Lithuania's largest bird. Lives in rocky areas, wooded areas to the larger ponds, lakes and rivers.

Baltoji pelėda

White owl

One of the largest owl species. All white, only the shoulders, wings and the lower side of the body spotted with brown



Juodakaklis naras

Black-throated diver

Head and neck top gray .
Loins half black, printed
with large white spots.
Neck and dewlap sides
with black and white
stripes. Body sides are
black, white chest.
