






1. Do you know that Soğuksu National Park is in the border of Ankara?



name of the park or they have




2. If you have been to Soğuksu National Park, have you visited the museum inside the park?


3. Do you know that Soğuksu National Park is rich in spa resources?

4. Do you know that Black Vulture is one of the endangered species in Soğuksu National Park in Turkey?




