FAUNA IN RISNJAK NP

Risnjak NP is home to 3 large European predators:

wolves





a lynx = cro. 'ris' → Risnjak

LYNX

- an endangered species in Croatia
 (only 40-60 in Croatia)
- probably the rarest and most
 hidden beast living in Europe

Lat. *Lynx lynx* Cro. ris Eng. Lynx



WOLF a <u>threatened</u> species (160 - 210 in CRO)

project LIFE: 2 packs are being traced



sharp hearing,but poor smell

Lat. *Canis lupus* Cro. vuk Eng. Wolf

BROWN BEAR

primarily a nocturnal animal

* can weigh up to 300 kg

Lat. *Ursus arctos* Cro. mrki medvjed Eng. Brown bear

it's allowed to hunt bears in Croatia





CHAMOIS



- adapted to steep rocky terrain
- known to live at
 - moderately high altitudes
- re-introduction into nature

Lat. *Rupicapra rupicapra balcanica* Cro. divokoza Eng. Chamois



- a protected species
- can weigh up to 15 kg
- bigger tail than a domestic
 cat
- many threats to survival



Lat. *Felis silvestris* Cro. divlja mačka Eng. Wild cat

BROWN TROUT

- lives in cold rivers and streams that are rich in oxygen
- in the NP you can enjoy 'catch and release' fishing on the Kupa river



Lat. *Salmo trutta* Cro. pastrva Eng. Brown trout

NOSE-HORNED VIPER

- the most dangerous and
 venomous European snake
- * afraid of water
- horn on its nose & zig-zag pattern
 - Lat. *Vipera ammodytes* Cro. poskok Eng. Nose-horned viper







114 bird species

26 threatened species





CAPERCAILLE

* an endangered species in Croatia

feeds on blueberries,
 insects and leaves

Lat. *Tetrao urogallus*

Cro. tetrijeb

Eng. Western capercaillie



PEREGRINE FALCON

a vulnerable species in Croatia
 (160-200 pairs)

the fastest animal – can reach over
 300 km/h during its hunting stoop



Lat. Falco peregrinus

Cro. sivi sokol

Eng. Peregrine falcon

PYGMY OWL

a vulnerable species in Croatia

the smallest owl in Europe
 length: 17-19 cm
 weight: up to 80 g

Lat. *Glaucidium passerinum* Cro. mali ćuk Eng. Pygmy Owl



BUTTERFLIES

89 species of butterflies (11 endangered)

Valley of butterflies:
 in the valley of the Kupa river
