**Protect the environment,
natural and cultural
heritage objects (values),
save natural resources**



**Fishing, hunting in accordance
with procedure approved by the
Minister of Environment and
other legal statutory
requirements**



Make fires, build tents and motor vehicles for short-term accommodation for recreation purposes are allowable only in specially equipped and marked places (campsites, resorts, camping sites).



**Don't touch the rights and interests
other users of natural resources**



Park visitors must respect natural resources rights and interests.

**Sort the waste and follow
other approved local waste
management regulations.**
